Tomorrow, many students at LCVI will be writing the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT). Passing this test is a requirement for students to earn their Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

In order to accommodate the administration of this test and to allow students the best opportunity for success, there are some changes to the regular schedule at Calvin Park and some additional temporary measures we will put in place on **Tuesday, April 10, 2018** to support students and staff at LCVI.

Schedule Changes

- Lunch Recess: 11:05 a.m. – 11:45 a.m. (*typically 12:15 p.m. – 12:55 p.m.*)
- Lunch Eating Time: 11:45 a.m. – 12:05 p.m. (*typically 11:55 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.*)
- Period 4: 12:05 p.m. – 12:55 p.m. (*typically 11:05 a.m. – 11:55 a.m.*)

No Cafeteria Service

There is no cafeteria service for Calvin Park students on Tuesday, April 10, 2018. **Students should bring a lunch to school.** If students forget, our lunch program will continue to operate as per usual out of Room 214 beginning April 10 at 11:45 a.m. and any student may access it as required.

Lower-Tech Activities Periods 1 to 3

To assist with bandwidth issues over WiFi, and to give priority network access to secondary students, elementary students will continue to be engaged in rich learning, though perhaps via lower tech activities in the morning.

Personal Devices to Airplane Mode

Elementary and secondary students will be asked to switch personal devices to airplane mode on the morning of April 10 as another way to assist with priority access to WiFi for students writing the OSSLT.
